## OFF-SITE HAND PAPERMAKING

**This class is a formal introduction to basic papermaking techniques with the Morgan Conservatory. The session will begin with a discussion of how various fibers (cotton, flax, abaca, and hemp) are prepared. Students will learn the terms used when making paper and go through the process of forming their own sheets of paper. The papers will then be pressed, dried and returned to the students within one week of the class. (Please note that the Morgan reserves a few samples of the student work for the Morgan archives.)**

Facilitation includes 1 Teacher and 1 Assistant and all items necessary to conduct the class.

Session length 4 to 6 hours per day.

The facility is asked to provide:

- Work space with floors that accommodate water
- Work Tables
- Water Source and a Drain
